The cattle business is the people business, and we enjoy building new relationships as well as growing old ones through seedstock cattle. We would like to personally thank everyone who has taken an interest in the offering this year and in previous years. Whether you are a past customer, or considering becoming a new one, we can't continue to do this without your support, and we will continually strive to improve the cattle being offered so your cowherd can become more profitable.

The Red Angus breed has continued its unprecedented growth for a variety of reasons: exceptional carcass merit and opportunity for premiums at harvest, accuracy of EPDs, and adding value to commercial cross breeding systems. However, we feel the most important reason to be using Red Angus genetics is the momma cow. Her ability to calve easy, keep her flesh, breed back in a timely manner, and then still push the scales at weaning time is what has solidified the breed's place as second amongst all other breeds in America.

Our first and highest priority when making selection decisions is on the female. If we didn't feel that these bulls' daughters could work in any part of the country, they would not be offered. It is the cow family behind the bull that separates the average from the best. We have continued to build a breeding program based around some of the most proven maternal genetics that North America has to offer. We do not have any cooperators, and these animals have never left the place. We take pride in knowing our cattle very well.

I would like to point out that many of the bulls in the offering are embryo transfer calves. I have identified those in the footnotes. Please keep in mind that the actual BWs on those individuals are not indicative of their true genetics, but more indicative of their recipient mother's birthweight tendencies. Because the association's EPDs are being updated weekly, it is continually important to measure a bull's value based on the percentile ranking of whichever trait is being evaluated. Those percentiles are listed below the EPD values.

EPDs are a proven tool that we use in our program, but they are not the focal point of the selection process. In our search for superior genetics, we have found that there tends to be a discrepancy in many mainstream bloodlines with breed leading EPD values, and real world functionality. Many times, genetic selection decisions tend to be made on the computer playing with numbers rather than using visual appraisal and common sense. At the end of the day, there are plenty of high numbered red angus cattle out there that don't have the physical attributes to either be as good as their numbers suggest, or to plain work at all in a non forgiving production environment.

Finally, our aim is to raise bulls that may not be the extreme from an EPD profile standpoint, but are balanced in their numbers, individual performance, and have ample rib shape and muscle, while also improving feet and udder structure in their daughters. We realize that this may seem unrealistic to some, but that is our goal as breeders to identify the cattle that can consistently do this, and ultimately help to improve our customer's bottom line.

Aside from infertility, all other guarantees will be made through insurance only. For customers who choose to insure their bulls on sale day, York Creek Red Angus will pay 50% of the policy premium for Options 1-3, or up to 6.25% for Option 4 listed on the following insurance page. Insurance representatives will be present at the sale to insure purchases in person and over the phone. There is free delivery within 300 miles, and free boarding until April 1. We will still be offering a \$100 cash discount to anyone wanting to take his or her bull home directly after the sale. Once again, thank you very much for your interest in the program, and if you have any questions please don't hesitate to give us a call or swing by anytime to take a look at the bulls or cowherd. Where to start with this string of Foreigner descendants? I guess I should start by prefacing this sire group with a little background information on their daddy, YCRA Foreigner E127. I firmly believe that the vast majority of purebred and commercial cattle could use a shot of efficiency. "Efficiency" is a term that gets thrown around about as much as the word "moderate" anymore, but to me, that means a cow that is truly grazing well over 300 days of the year. That is something that tends to be overlooked in this world of high input high output economics, but long story short, although we operate in farm country, I have found out the hard way that I do not want to "farm" my cows. Keeping cows working for us, and not the other way around is much less expensive and much more enjoyable.

Many times you scroll through a program's history, and they trace back to a single bull or female that they identified as timelessly influential, and then expanded upon that genetic cornerstone. I feel that Foreigner E127 is the sire that may possibly be that for us because of his ability to consistently transmit genetics that will perform in the management I discussed before. He is the most calving ease sire we have ever used, both naturally and artificially. He is as wide as he is tall, jammed full of muscle, and moves like a cat. On top of his extreme athleticism and exceptional foot structure, he is the most aggressive breeder I have ever witnessed. He literally cuts through a group of cows like butter. I prefer to keep cows in larger groups for management purposes, as well as it allows competition amongst breeding bulls. The higher fertility, higher libido, better footed bulls always outperform. In his group of roughly 100 cows he has been in this fall, I fully expect him to have sired over half of the coming calf crop in a 60 day window.

We are beginning a complete transition to fall calving, because I believe we can run a cow more in sync with our forage resources, but also because I am excited to offer a more complete, ready-made product to our customers. These 18 month old bulls are ready to service a larger number of females in their first season, and because of grazing based development they will cover more ground and hold their flesh.

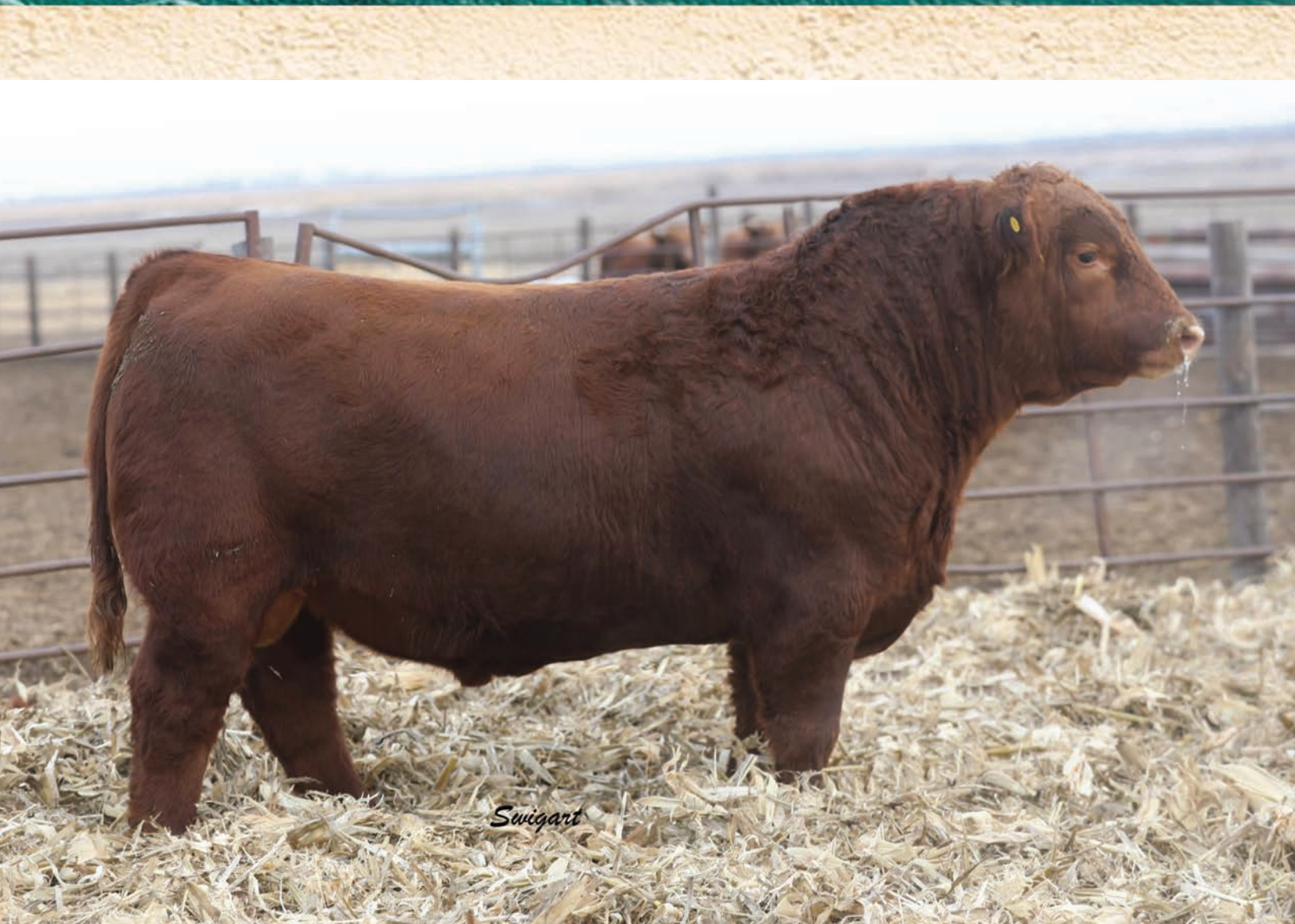
